



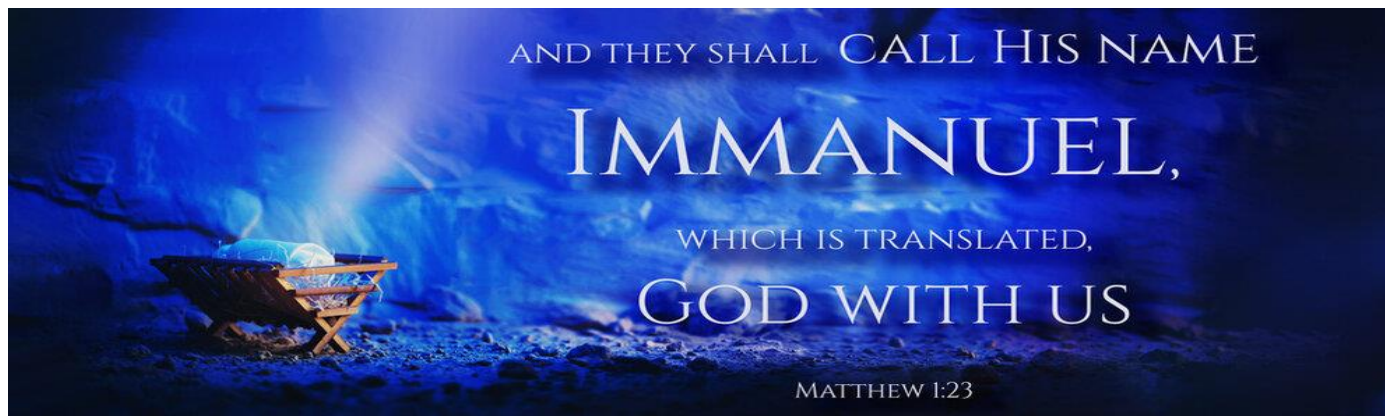

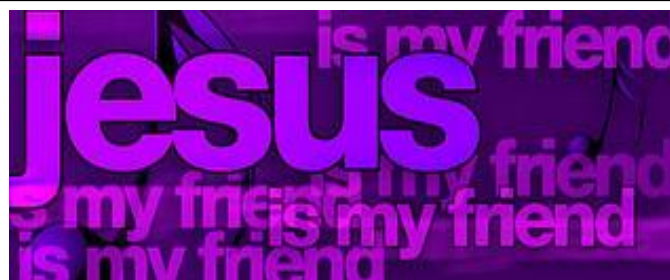

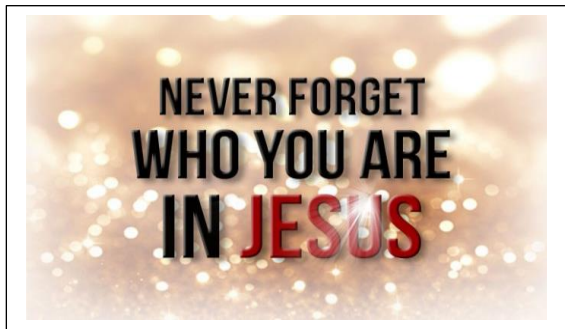
from the UK believe God has called them to come over as long-term missionaries. Hannah has already been a few times in the past and Ryan once

We had the wonderful privilege of receiving a few dentists from Australia recently who came over and have done an incredible job in our dental clinic. Dr. Toni, who comes almost every year volunteering her services together with a few other fantastic dentists and helpers to do all the dental work that needs to be done on all our children, youth and even adults. A number of our local nurses and medical people helped as well and they got to learn a lot of new skills from these fabulous professional volunteers. Together they did an amazing 960 check-ups, 166 extractions and 415 fillings all in a matter of 4 weeks. Absolutely fantastic. We are still hoping that some of our young people here want to learn to become a dentist and desire to serve the Lord here in our village. So far no takers yet.

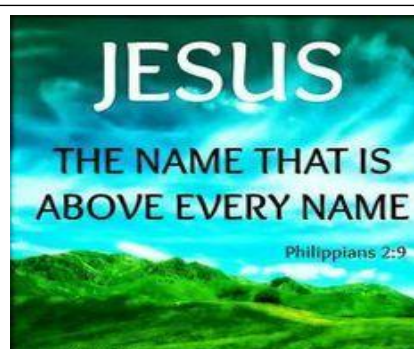

Our very first primary school computer room already in full use. We will need to organise another computer class room very soon.

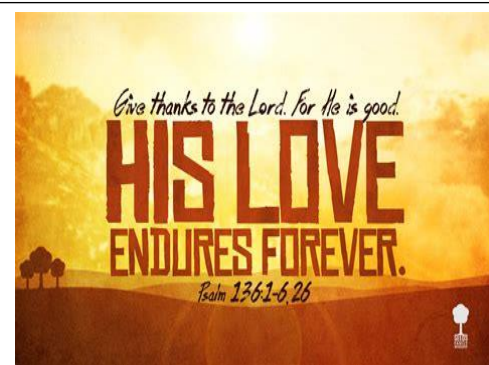

A huge thank you to Dr David and his translator from Jakarta, Ibu Vernny. They have done an incredible job blessing our people here.

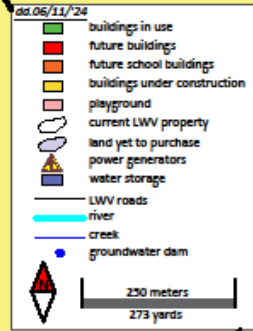

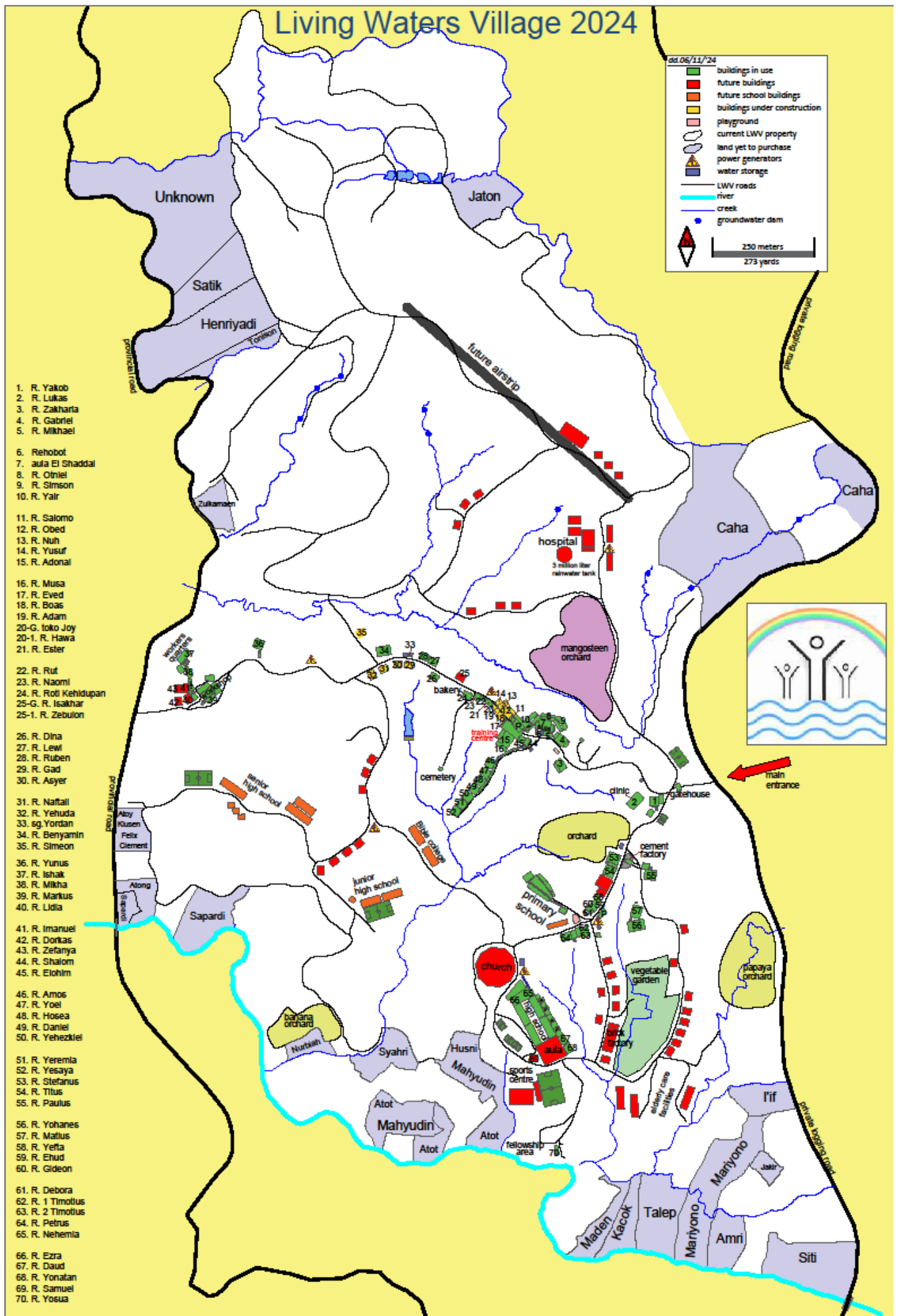

### **Building Progress:**

Our numerous building projects are being built full-steam-ahead. Sometimes I wonder if we haven't started a little too much at the same time but then again there is so much that is urgent as the village just keeps on growing with more and more children and youth arriving. We have just completed another water tower which provides spring water to a new area with a number of new children's homes. Two massive underground water tanks have been built also to catch rainwater for drinking for those new homes. A new Generator shed was completed to house the two new Japanese (Denyo) generators which we just received recently. What an incredible blessing these machines are. These two machines were made possible thanks to a lovely sister in the Lord from Singapore and a few other people around the world. A huge thank you to you all.

We have commenced with concreting another section of road between Benjamin's House and our High School. It's about 1½ km in length and is a huge job with km's of large gutters to be built as well as storm water drains for the torrential downpours we regularly experience here in the tropics. Once this road has been completed, we can start building our Bible College. A vast area has been set aside for this project which has already been levelled. Our Bible College is currently facilitated in one of our High School buildings.

Our old water pump station at our river has been renovated and modified into a home for one of our families for the very purpose to oversee the security of our dredging equipment which is used to dredge sand out of the river for our concrete plant. In the past people from other villages would come during the night, dismantle parts of the dredge engine and steal them. The river is one of our borders hence easy for people to come and steal things. Now with a security home right next door to the dredging equipment with a huge flood light shining on it, thieves are deterred from coming over. This house we have named "Joshua House".

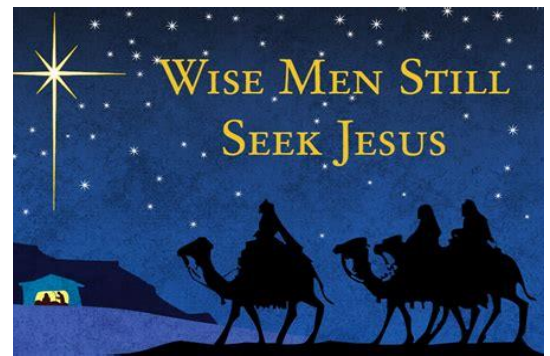

Three new children's homes named Dina, Levi and Ruben are completed and already occupied with stacks of children and house parents. The houses are great and are a wonderful home for our children and youth who are living there now. A lot of hard work has gone into them. Many volunteers from around the world have been involved helping us in some way or form to get these homes ready together with a lot of our youth and workers we employ from outside. The opening of these houses has alleviated the pressure on our training centre which was a little overcrowded. More houses are being built which will hopefully be ready in a few months' time.

We have been blessed with the arrival of a new small truck which we urgently needed due to the many projects we are building at the same time. Another similar small truck has been ordered as more funds for these trucks have come in which is fantastic and such a blessing. We have also received eight new motorbikes of which five are for our church-planters who live in remote regions and three motorbikes for use in our village. Thank you to all those people who have contributed to these vital vehicles for the Lord's work here. Distances are huge here and motorbikes are a wonderful tool to get quickly to difficult, remote areas.

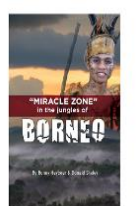

### Postal address changes:

Our ministry is located in the Indonesian part of Borneo but our Postal address is located in the Malaysian part of Borneo for the simple reason that the Malaysian postal services are a bit more reliable. We have a Post Box in Kuching, Malaysia already for years but have noticed that a number of parcels each year are sent back to the sender rather quickly for whatever reason which is such a waste of resources. Hence, we have decided to use the house address of one of our Malaysian ministry partners. We will still also use our P.O Box for perhaps a year or two to make sure the transition doesn't lose any mail. Hence our NEW Postal Address is:

### A gentle Warning:

Regularly our youth, and sometimes our children, leave our village for all sorts of reasons. Either it's because they have finished school or someone from their family or tribe decides to take them back to their village or sometimes other reasons. None of our youth and children are ever allowed to have any contact details of their sponsor. This is to protect our children and the sponsors. However, sometimes when they leave, they seem to find their previous sponsors contact details through social media and start to communicate with them directly. Unfortunately, we have discovered a number of times that the children or youth, through pressure from their relatives or friends, ask for financial help towards medical help for someone, building materials for their home or church and all sorts of other things. Sometimes these requests are genuine and sometimes they are definitely not and the funds are used for something totally different. We would like to advise you not to give in to any of these requests as it often causes all sorts of problems for them, for you and even for us here.

Some sponsors have indicated that they would like to include our ministry "Living Waters Village or Rivers of Life Ministries Borneo" in their will which is wonderful and very welcome. Also, some sponsors would like to leave something in their will for their sponsored child/youth but this would cause major problems for us as a ministry here due to all sorts of legal and cultural issues. Hence, we would ask you **NOT** to leave anything in your will specifically for your sponsored child/youth but instead leave it to our ministry here so that we can help many children and youth in crisis. If you need more information or clarification, please do not hesitate to contact us.

### Prayer Points:

- Although we were very blessed with two new generators, we still need to order two more, but with a slightly bigger kilowatt capacity in order to service the many new buildings in progress that will be added to the training center region. Please pray with us that funds will arrive for these massive machines which should last us for the next 20 -30 years according to the manufacturer in Japan. Each 200 KVA generator will cost USD 114,400.-
- For another pick-up truck which will be changed into a passenger truck to transport people on the property and to the nearest towns. This will cost approximately USD 31,824.-
- For all our church-planters who live in remote regions and doing a marvelous task in shining for Jesus where they are placed, bringing a wonderful harvest of souls into God's Kingdom.
- For the remaining land still to be purchased in various places around our property as you can see on the map enclosed. These pieces of land are vital so that people now, and in the future, will not be able to dispute borders as our borders will then be almost all natural boundaries (roads, river & creek). Each hectare of property costs now approximately USD 3,009.- We still need to purchase around 30 hectares (App 80 acres).

**All of us here in our village thank you all immensely for your huge input in the lives of all our children and youth. You are a blessing. Thank you again.
